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## Q. What level of control during a system emergency does Hydro have over NP-owned generation?

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A. Hydro has overall responsibility for the generation dispatch function on the Island Interconnected System. On a daily basis Newfoundland Power provides Hydro with a list of the Company's generating units that are available and their maximum generating capacity. Hydro effectively has full control over Newfoundland Power owned generating units during a system emergency.

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14 15 Hydro follows its System Operating Instruction T-001 when a system generation shortfall is forecasted to occur or develops when generating units go off-line unexpectedly. This System Operating Instruction outlines a number of sequential steps to be taken to respond to the system generation capacity shortfall situation. The steps include Hydro giving instructions to Newfoundland Power to run all available hydro units to maximum output and when to place the Company's standby gas turbine and diesel generating units online.
