9	A.	The referenced Energy and Capacity Agreement provides the complete detail of
10		Nalcor's delivery obligations to Emera; however, a concise summary of the
11		obligations is for the delivery of the Nova Scotia Block which includes:
12		 0.98 TWh of energy annually from Muskrat Falls to be delivered to
13		Woodbine, Nova Scotia at a constant capacity less the associated
14		transmission losses, seven days per week, 16 hours per day, between
15		0700 APT and 2300 APT for a period of 35 years.
16		 Any Supplemental Energy as outlined in Schedule 4 of the Energy and
17		Capacity Agreement. Supplemental Energy would be amounts of energy
18		owing to compensate for the adjustment of the amortization of the
19		Maritime Link Assets from 50 to 35 years. Final determination of any
20		requirement for Supplemental Energy cannot be made until after First

Commercial Power. Any Supplemental Energy required would be
