Q.	The January 2014 outages showed that in addition to the Holyrood issues, system
	disruptions occurred due to issues with the other power supply equipment
	[Sunnyside and Western Avalon transformers, Sunnyside Bus protection failure].
	Please explain how reliability risks relating to such other power supply equipment
	issues are addressed in Hydro's report, and the potential for such other reliability
	risks to once again aggravate IIS disruptions.
A.	As detailed in Section 5 of the Energy Supply Risk Assessment (ESRA) Report, Hydro
	has made significant investment in infrastructure, including other power supply
	equipment, in recent years to improve reliability for customers and will continue to
	do so into the future. In this way, Hydro continues to address reliability risks
	relating to other power supply equipment issues.
	Studies and assessments of the availability of such power supply equipment are
	conducted as part of Hydro's Asset Management practises, and remediation efforts
	if required, would be included in Hydro's Annual Work plan.
