1	Q.	Further to the response to PUB-NLH-019, is there a minimum available reserve that
2		triggers a decision by Hydro to issue a conservation request to customers? If yes,
3		state what it is. If no, why not?

A. Hydro monitors the projected reserve using the seven-day load forecast and projected capacity availability. Due to the range of variability in the seven-day load forecasts, rather than having a minimum operating reserve (in terms of MW or percentage of available generation capacity), Hydro assesses the likelihood of load on the power system approaching the available capacity to determine when conservation may provide a benefit. When Hydro determines this may occur, it would initiate both an internal discussion and a discussion with Newfoundland Power on the appropriate timing for a conservation request to be most effective to avoid rotating outages but also balance matters noted in Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-051.
