Hydro manages the operation of the distribution system from Transmission and Rural Operations (TRO) regional offices for planned outages and response to unplanned outages and trouble calls. The Distribution Frontline Supervisor is responsible for directing work on the distribution system and acts as the controlling authority for work protection. Outages are planned by the Short Term Planning and Scheduling group and communicated to customers via the Support Services group. Technical support with respect to monitoring the performance of the distribution system is the responsibility of the Long Term Asset Planning group via Asset Specialists and Equipment Engineers. Succession plans for key leadership positions are described in Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-167 and a listing of personnel who perform work on the distribution systems is described in Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-183.
