9 The changes from the April 2013 version were as follows:

11 (a) In order to strengthen communication efforts during an alert or emergency,
12 the EOC or designate, in addition to updating the alert line, will also be required to
13 forward updates to the CERP team via email. At the conclusion of an alert or
14 emergency, the EOC will be also be required to forward an email to the CERP team,
15 in addition to updating the alert line, advising them to “stand down”.
