

1 Q. Further to the response to PUB-NLH-264, which outlines that the curtailment of the  
2 Maritime Link is necessary for a wide range of faults, as described in Attachment 1,  
3 and is an essential part of limiting future load shedding to permanent bipole faults,  
4 state which part(s) of the Interconnection Operators Agreement or any other  
5 agreement confirms Nova Scotia Power Incorporated's agreement to this  
6 instantaneous curtailment of the Maritime Link and provide a copy setting out the  
7 sections of such agreement.
