Q. Further to PUB-NLH-617, Hydro does not have an agreement in place with Nova 1 2 Scotia and New Brunswick in respect of the provision of emergency power support. 3 However, assuming that 157 MW was being delivered to Nova Scotia before the bipole outage, and that 300 MW could be made available for Island Interconnected 4 system, please provide an estimate of the time that a responsible network operator 5 6 would require to re-organise the generation and network settings, before the 7 Maritime Link could start to ramp up power delivery to the Island Interconnected 8 system. 9 10 11 Α. Studies relating to the import of capacity over the Maritime Link are ongoing and it will be later this year before the detail regarding the timeframes for initiating 12 13 imports over the link will be known.
