Hydro is working on the remaining responses to the GRK RFIs as well as the outstanding Newfoundland Power RFIs. The outstanding NP RFIs in particular were of a detailed technical nature and many are inter-related and thus Hydro requires more time to provide a complete response. Hydro is continuing to work on these responses as well as preparing various update reports to the Board and ensuring completion of its winter readiness, and will provide the outstanding responses as soon as it is able.
