Re: The Board's Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected System- Phase One Schedule

This is further to correspondence dated October 31, 2014 on the schedule for Phase One.

As contemplated by the previous correspondence, Liberty's reports were filed on December 18, 2014. The schedule for the next steps in Phase One, as discussed at a counsel meeting on January 7, 2015, is set out below:

January 12, 2015
January 28, 2015
February 5, 2015

RFIs on Liberty's Reports and to other parties
Responses to the RFIs filed on January 12th
Submissions by Hydro and Newfoundland Power
including their positions on Liberty's Reports

The parties advised at the January 7, 2015 counsel meeting that they were not filing expert reports in the Phase One proceeding and therefore no schedule has been established relating to such reports.

A counsel meeting will be scheduled to discuss the scope and timing of the public hearing for Phase One following the filing of the utilities' submissions. At this time it is anticipated that the hearing will be held in late winter/early spring.

The schedule for Phase Two, which focuses on the implications of the interconnection with Muskrat Falls on the reliability and adequacy of the Island Interconnected system, will be dealt with separately.
