Re: Investigation and Hearing into Supply Issues and Power Outages on the Island Interconnected System – Phase Two – Availability of Information and Ongoing Reporting and Monitoring

In its letter of July 21, 2017 the Board stated that immediate additional reporting was required and identified information to be filed by Hydro. The Board also advised that further direction on additional reporting and monitoring activities would be provided following review of the requested information.

On August 4, 2017 Hydro filed its response to the Board's direction. Following review of the information the Board has determined that additional reporting and ongoing monitoring is required. The Board has engaged Liberty to assist in determining an appropriate monitoring framework, including regular reporting by Hydro, to allow the Board to receive information on specific measures and track progress against milestones. This information is critical for the Board to assess the adequacy and reliability of supply for the Island Interconnected system and whether any additional measures are required both before and after interconnection. Liberty will contact Hydro to arrange preliminary meetings regarding the scope and timing of the monitoring program.
