13	A.	A siting evaluation is not included in Liberty's work and, in any event, we do not
14		have the information required to determine an optimum location for new generation.
15		Given that the Avalon is the major load center, and the Labrador Island Link delivers

to the Avalon, it would seem reasonable to assume that standby capacity should be

located on or near the Avalon; however, Liberty has not considered all of the factors

and analyses that Hydro might appropriately choose to include in such a study.
