Re: Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") – Network Additions Policy Review and Labrador Interconnected System Expansion Study

By letter dated May 1, 2019, the Board set today as the deadline for comments following the filing of expert reports in the captioned proceeding.

Hydro has confirmed that the proposed Network Addition Policy for the Labrador Interconnected System was developed based on considerations specific to the Labrador Interconnected System, and that, in Hydro's view, there is no requirement for development of a similar policy for the Island Interconnected System at this time.¹ For this reason, Newfoundland Power does not have any comments on the matter at this time.
