Please explain how these factors are assessed, weighted, and factored into the prioritization 4 5 matrix, and provide an illustrative example. 6 7 In each of the 14 scoring categories the impact/probability is multiplied by the category score. 8 Α. 9 The total score from each category (selected score multiplied by impact/probability) is added together to provide the total overall score. For example, in the Overhaul Unit 1 Turbine and 10 11 Valves - Holyrood project, the schedule risk had a score of 65 (no anticipated schedule conflicts) 12 with a confidence level of 3 (likely) resulting in a total score for the schedule risk category of 195. 13
