If so, please explain including potential cost impacts. 5 6 In moving to a N-2 redundancy, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") would incur the 7 A. 8 incremental cost of operating and maintaining a fourth genset, including planned maintenance 9 and corrective maintenance. There would also be an increase in the total station service energy 10 use as the new unit has electric heaters to keep the unit warm, similar to the other three units 11 on site. These expenses will be offset by operational efficiencies associated with the installation of the new genset. Please refer to Hydro's response to PUB-NLH-004 for further detail. 12
