

1 Q. **Reference: Volume II, 2022 Capital Projects over \$200,000 but less than \$500,000,**
2 **Additions for Load (2022) – Mary’s Harbour Service Conductor, page 69, Tables 1 and 2.**

3 Please reconcile the differences between the forecasts in Tables 1 and 2 with the operating load
4 forecasts provided in Appendix A of Attachment 1, *Long Term Supply Study for Charlottetown,*
5 *Economic and Technical Assessment* to the Application for the construction of Phase 1 of
6 Hydro’s long-term plan for Southern Labrador.

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9 A. The operating load forecast provided in Appendix A of Attachment 1 to the application for the
10 construction of Phase 1 of Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro’s (“Hydro”) long-term plan for
11 southern Labrador¹ was developed in August 2020 for the Southern Labrador Interconnection
12 Study. That operating load forecast from Appendix A includes the impact of the new cod plant
13 based on a preliminary request for service provided to Hydro by the cod plant in July 2020. The
14 forecast included in Table 1 of the referenced project report was also completed in August 2020
15 but does not include the impact of the proposed cod plant. The forecast included in Table 2 of
16 the report was developed in March 2021 and includes the finalized request for service from the
17 cod plant which was received in March 2021.
