## Q. Reference: Power Sales - General

Does Hydro or any of its related corporations, including NEMC, have any long-term contacts for Export Power Sales? If so, provide details as to quantities sold, gross and net revenues and a comparison with the prices in the New England Mass Hub and New York Zone A.

A. Nalcor Energy ("Nalcor") has a long-term contract called the Energy Access Agreement. Under this contract, which extends until August 31, 2041, Nalcor agreed to offer an average of 1.2 TWh per year of surplus non-firm energy into Nova Scotia Power Inc.'s ("Nova Scotia Power") annual solicitations for energy. Under the contract, Nalcor's offering in such solicitations cannot exceed a maximum price equal to New England Massachusetts Hub Day-Ahead pricing. The first such solicitation occurred in 2022 for the first contract year, which began September 1, 2022.
