Q. Schedule 3, page 4 of 5. Component "C" of the non-firm energy charge based on thermal generation source is "the average system losses on the Island Interconnected grid for the last five years ending in 2016 (3.34%)." Please explain why Hydro is proposing the last five years ending in 2016 as opposed to the last five years ending in a more recent timeframe.

A. It has been past practice for Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") to update the average system losses percentage for the Island Industrial Non-Firm Rate in its general rate application proceeding. Therefore, Hydro did not update the percentage at this time. The proposed update to the Island Industrial Non-Firm Rate in the current application was solely to reflect that an alternate source of generation should also be considered when computing the non-firm rate (and not just the incremental cost of thermal generation to supply non-firm energy).
