3 with Newfoundland Power, the preliminary estimate of the overall average
4 customer rate impact resulting from Hydro's proposed rate adjustments
5 and Newfoundland Power's projected rate adjustments is approximately a
6 6.9% increase effective July 1, 2023.

7 Please provide Newfoundland Power's projected calculations of its Rate
8 Stabilization Account and Municipal Tax Adjustment factors and provide
9 the resulting rate impacts.
