



**NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR HYDRO
MAJOR CAPITAL WORKS APPLICATION
Bay d’Espoir Unit 8 and Avalon Combustion Turbine**

THE APPLICATION

On March 21, 2025 the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities received an application from Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro requesting approval of:

- i) capital expenditures in the amount of \$1.08 billion for an additional 150 MW unit at the Bay d’Espoir hydroelectric generating facility, with anticipated completion in 2031; and
- ii) capital expenditures in the amount of \$891 million for a new 150 MW multi-unit combustion turbine facility with renewable fuel capability at the Holyrood Thermal Generating Station, with anticipated completion in 2029.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE

Anyone can participate in the application by becoming an intervenor, by making a presentation or by submitting a letter of comment. Intervenor submissions must be filed with the Board by **3:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 29, 2025**. Intervenor submissions must satisfy the requirements set out in section 9 of the *Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities Regulations, 1996*. All participants must provide full contact information including name, address and phone number.
