What is the all-in average rate for all end-use customers on the Island Interconnected System?
What is the current rate for residential customers on the Island Interconnected System, both all-

4 in and energy charge only?

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A. The average all-in rate for Domestic and General Service customers is more appropriately sourced from Newfoundland Power Inc. as the primary retail provider of such service on the Island Interconnected System.

Table 1 provides the Energy Only rates for each customer class on the Island Interconnected System as of August 1, 2024, the average all-in rate for Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro's ("Hydro") Industrial customers, and the domestic average all-in rate based on information available to Hydro.
