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Does Hydro anticipate that the execution of any of the capital projects identified in the five-year plan will impact the available capacity of the Bay d'Espoir plant during the peak winter season?

A. No, where possible, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") plans the execution of capital projects in such a manner as to minimize generation unavailability during the winter readiness period.¹ This remains true for all projects identified in the five-year plan for the Bay d'Espoir Hydroelectric Generating Station; however, Hydro will continue to assess its annual work plans and outage schedules to ensure adequate generation and required reserves are available in each year a project is targeted for execution and will provide updates in its winter readiness reporting.

¹ The winter readiness period begins December 1 and concludes March 31 of each year.
