Q. Reference: General

Hydro has a number of capital programs in its capital budget. Given the current circumstances of regular increases in capital expenditures, what would be the impacts (both financial and operational) of reducing the budget for capital programs (i.e. not specific capital projects) in the range of 3% to 5%?

A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") does not submit a capital budget proposal for approval unless it is deemed necessary for the generation and transmission of safe, reliable, environmentally responsible power in the province, using the best information available at the time of the application. A 3% to 5% reduction of the capital budget would thus represent the elimination of work that is deemed necessary for the delivery of safe, reliable, environmentally responsible power, and presents unreasonable risks to operations, staff and customers.
