Hydro follows the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador's ("Government") Aboriginal Consultation Policy on Land and Resource Development Decisions. In the Policy, the Government commits to ensuring meaningful consultation of peoples with asserted rights for any land and resource developments that have the potential to adversely impact those asserted rights. Therefore, Hydro evaluates projects it undertakes for the potential to create such adverse impacts and plans consultation on this basis. There are no projects included in the 2025 Capital Budget Application that Hydro believes have this potential.
