 6 electric vehicle charging load at the customer's facility during periods of
 7 system constraints? Please explain.

- 9 **PUB-NLH-003** Please provide details on the number and type of service requests in excess of
 10 200 kW in Labrador West since 2020, excluding cryptocurrency companies,
 11 and explain the criteria applied by Hydro to determine whether to request
 12 Board approval for an exemption to Regulation 17.
