2 Describe the security in place at the Bay d'Espoir site and if public access is controlled to any
3 extent. Include whether public access to Camp Boggy Road is available from an insecure access
4 point.

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7 A. Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro maintains security operations 24 hours per day, 7 days per
8 week at the Bay d'Espoir site, which is accessed via Camp Boggy Road. Gates and controlled
9 access points are in place at key locations throughout the development to restrict unauthorized
10 access to critical operational areas and infrastructure. Public access remains available to
11 portions of the road network that have historically been used for recreational and commercial
12 purposes, including the Intake Access Road.
