project." What other projects have been deferred beyond 2021 to allow further

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A. No other projects have been deferred beyond 2021 to allow further study of system requirements following commissioning of the Muskrat Falls Project.

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Newfoundland Power's 2021 Capital Plan lists 3 capital projects originally planned for 2021 that were deferred. Of these, only replacement of the St. John's Teleprotection System was deferred in order to allow further study of system requirements following commissioning of the Muskrat Falls Project. Newfoundland Power's existing teleprotection system is obsolete. However, the specific replacement solution required is dependent upon verifying the requirements for high speed transmission line protection on the St. John's transmission network post Muskrat Falls Project commissioning.
