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A. Newfoundland Power does not have access to data on transmission and distribution ("T&D") operating and maintenance costs of other Canadian Electricity Association ("CEA") Region 2 utilities. This data is not publicly available.

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Table 1 extends the table referenced in this question to provide the aggregate capital investment in T&D assets for other major distribution utilities in CEA Region 2.

Atlantic Canadian utilities include the primary distributors of electricity in each province: Nova Scotia Power, NB Power, and Maritime Electric. Each of these utilities is considered a CEA Region 2 utility.

The other major distribution utilities included in the analysis are Hydro Quebec, Hydro One and BC Hydro.
