EY has not audited, reviewed or otherwise attempted to verify the accuracy or completeness of such information." Did EY simply accept what was provided by Newfoundland Power staff without any attempt to verify the accuracy or completeness of such information? Please explain the process followed by EY.
- 8 A. The disclaimer is used to notify the reader that this is a consulting engagement, not an audit/assurance engagement.
- In performing the services, we exercised due professional care. There was adequate planning and supervision conducted in the performance of the services. EY obtained sufficient relevant data to afford a reasonable basis for our conclusions/recommendations. The services were performed by individuals with professional competence.
