

1 **Q. EV Charging Network – Exhibit 2**  
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3 **On page 6, Newfoundland Power notes that it has applied for \$550,000 in federal**  
4 **funding for the construction of the EV Charging Network for 2021, and if approved**  
5 **it will reduce the overall capital costs borne by customers. Footnote 22 on the same**  
6 **page indicates that the Utilities have applied for \$1 million in funding to install 19**  
7 **charging sites. Does this mean that Hydro will receive the remaining \$450,000 of this**  
8 **funding and will also be constructing 9 additional EV charging sites (not including**  
9 **the 14 sites previously approved by the Board) in the province during 2021?**

11 A. Yes, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro (“Hydro”) will receive the remaining portion of  
12 the funding. The total funding amount is \$1,045,000. Hydro will be provided with  
13 \$495,000.

15 Hydro will construct 9 additional EV charging sites in the province in 2021. These 9  
16 sites are in addition to the 14 sites previously approved by the Board.
