4 **Please explain the forecast decline in pole attachment revenue from 2021 to 2022**
5 **and 2023.**

7 A. Pole attachment revenue includes revenue collected by Newfoundland Power from cable
8 companies such as Rogers and Eastlink for attachments to utility poles. The revenue
9 collected is shared between Newfoundland Power and Bell Aliant based on a revenue
10 sharing arrangement contained in the parties’ *Joint Use Agreement*.
11
12 Higher forecast attachment revenue in 2021 reflects a one-time adjustment to balance the
13 amount owing to Bell Aliant in accordance with the *Joint Use Agreement*. The forecast
14 pole attachment revenue for 2022 and 2023 does not include this one-time adjustment.
