1 2 3	Q.	In the Capital Budget proposals, what independent verification is there to support the proposal?
4	A.	The Provisional Guidelines, when describing the requirement for Additional Supporting
5		Documentation states:
6		Where appropriate the utility is supported to provide additional
7 8		Where appropriate, the utility is expected to provide additional information such as a report/analysis by a qualified engineer,
9		independent consultant, or other appropriate expert, to justify the project
10		and/or program. For projects greater that \$5 million the utility should
11		provide this additional information. 1
12		
13		Each of the engineering project reports in the 2024 Capital Budget Application are
14		stamped and approved by internal qualified Professional Engineers. In situations where
15		Newfoundland Power does not have the internal expertise necessary, the Company
16		relies on third-party experts to complete an assessment and provide additional
17		information. For example, Newfoundland Power engaged a third-party consultant,
18		Kleinschmidt Canada Inc. to provide an inspection report for the Mobile Hydro Plant
19		Surge Tank Refurbishment project that involved a climbing inspection and assessment of
20		the corrosion present on the surge tank structure.
