- (Reference CA-NP-103) It is stated "While the design of Transmission Line Q. 146L is sub-standard, it does not necessarily mean that the line is currently unsafe to operate." Does it mean that it is more likely to fail going forward than in the past? Please explain.
  - Yes, as stated in the response to Request for Information CA-NP-103, the probability of failure of Transmission Line 146L has increased due to the deteriorated condition of the line combined with its sub-standard design and expected impacts of climate change on weather conditions. It is Newfoundland Power's view that, due to these factors, the probability that Transmission Line 146L will fail increases with time.
