Surge tank cross bracing wear plates were not originally installed on surge tanks of this vintage. Operational experience has shown that without wear plates, the structural cross bracing members will rub together resulting in cross sectional material loss.

Was this issue noted on the original mobile surge tank, which was replaced in 1999? If so, was the installation of wear plates considered during the design of the existing tank?

A. Newfoundland Power confirms that the issue was noted on the original surge tank in Mobile. The design of the 1999 surge tank was completed by Acres International. Newfoundland Power has recently reviewed the original 1999 construction documentation; however, the document is silent on why the plates were not considered for the design at that time.
