## Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro Request for Information NLH-NP-001

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NLH-NP-001

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In 2022, Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") advised the Board of Commissioners of Public Utilities ("Board") that, without intervention, the rate increase for the Island Industrial Customers through the annual Rate Stabilization Plan ("RSP") Adjustment would be approximately 23.6% due to the RSP Current Plan balance and the elimination of the RSP Fuel Rider. Hydro, in consultations with the Island Industrial Customers, filed a proposal with the Board that would materially reduce the rate increase for 2022 and allow the recovery of the RSP Current Plan balance over two years. Hydro believed this would contribute to rate stability, mitigate rate shock and achieve intergenerational equity through the use of a reasonable recovery period for the RSP Current Plan balance. Hydro's proposal was approved in Board Order No. P.U. 5(2022).
