  - A. a) The reliability data used by Newfoundland Power related to other utilities is obtained from databases maintained by Electricity Canada. Under Electricity Canada's confidentiality rules, data supplied to it by member utilities can only be produced in aggregate. Newfoundland Power is unable to provide reliability data pertaining to individual Atlantic Canadian utilities.
    - b) Table 1 provides requested information that compares Newfoundland Power to the average of the other Atlantic Canadian utilities on the basis of capital investment per customers.
