In 2024, the CBOC's forecast of housing starts and connections was higher than its forecast from the prior year. 1 Consequently, the forecast number of new customer connections for 2024 increased from 2,053 to 2,329. The higher forecast number of connections for 2025 resulted in a higher forecast budget associated with the Extensions and New Services programs in the 2025 Capital Budget Application.
