The Customer shall not resell the Service in whole or in part, except that the Customer may include the cost of Service in charges for the lease of space, or as part of the cost of other services provided by the Customer." Newfoundland Power was asked (CA-NP-123 pertaining to the 2025-2026 GRA) "Does Memorial University resell the service in whole or in part? Please explain." The response states "Newfoundland Power is not aware of whether Memorial University resells the service."
