

Schedule B 2025 Capital Projects and Programs Over \$750,000

Q. Pages 10-11, Distribution Feeders SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation.

Newfoundland Power states on page 10 that "The Distribution Feeder SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation project involves relocating sections of the St.

Catherine's ("SCT") substation distribution feeder and Blaketown ("BLK") substation distribution feeder to accommodate the Transmission Line 94L Rebuild project." Why is the Distributions Feeders SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation project presented as a separate project rather than being included as part of the Transmission Line 94L Rebuild project?

A. The *Distribution Feeders SCT-01* and *BLK-01* Relocation project is presented as a separate project rather than being included as part of the *Transmission Line 94L Rebuild* project because they involve work on different asset classes (distribution and transmission, respectively). Newfoundland Power organizes its capital projects partially on the basis of asset class.

Though these projects were presented separately in Newfoundland Power's 2025 Capital Budget Application, Schedule B, the costs associated with the Distribution Feeder SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation project were included as inputs to the net present value analysis completed as a part of the Transmission Line 94L Rebuild project assessment of alternatives.
