4 **Newfoundland Power states on page 10 that “*The Distribution Feeder SCT-01***
5 ***and BLK-01 Relocation* project involves relocating sections of the St.**
6 **Catherine’s (“SCT”) substation distribution feeder and Blaketown (“BLK”)**
7 **substation distribution feeder to accommodate the *Transmission Line 94L***
8 ***Rebuild* project.” Why is the *Distributions Feeders SCT-01 and BLK-01***
9 ***Relocation* project presented as a separate project rather than being included**
10 **as part of the *Transmission Line 94L Rebuild* project?**
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12 A. The *Distribution Feeders SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation* project is presented as a
13 separate project rather than being included as part of the *Transmission Line 94L Rebuild*
14 project because they involve work on different asset classes (distribution and
15 transmission, respectively). Newfoundland Power organizes its capital projects partially
16 on the basis of asset class.
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18 Though these projects were presented separately in Newfoundland Power’s *2025 Capital*
19 *Budget Application, Schedule B*, the costs associated with the *Distribution Feeder*
20 *SCT-01 and BLK-01 Relocation* project were included as inputs to the net present value
21 analysis completed as a part of the *Transmission Line 94L Rebuild* project assessment of
22 alternatives.
