A. In the 2013/2014 General Rate Application, Newfoundland Power proposed to merge Rate 2.1 and Rate 2.2 into a single rate class to eliminate the relatively large pricing differences which could result for similar electricity usage under the two rate classes at that time.¹

In Order No. P.U. 13 (2013), the Board ordered that Rates 2.1 and 2.2 be merged into a General Service Rate for all customers with demands of less than 100kW.²
