3	Q.	Has Newfoundland Power developed a 20-year capital plan giving consideration to
4		electrification initiatives? If yes, please provide a summary of the results. If not, is
5		Newfoundland Power planning to develop a long-term capital plan given the
6		potential for material investments potentially required for electrification initiatives.
7		If not, why not?
8		
9	A.	No, Newfoundland Power has not developed a 20-year capital plan considering
10		electrification initiatives. Although there is potential investment required for
11		electrification initiatives, Newfoundland Power is not planning to develop a long-term
12		capital plan at this time, due partially to uncertainty around electrification impacts and
13		uptake over the long-term. For information regarding how electrification initiatives are
14		incorporated into Newfoundland Power's 2024-2028 capital plan, see the response to
15		Request for Information PUB-NP-052.
16		
17		Longer-term outlooks are provided for specific capital projects, when required. For
18		example, Newfoundland Power's 2021 Capital Budget Application provided a 20-year
19 20		load forecast to justify the construction of a new substation near the St. John's
20		International Airport. This long-term forecast helped confirm that the new substation is
21		the least-cost alternative to meet customers' long-term electrical system requirements in
22		the area. <sup>1</sup> Additionally, Newfoundland Power completes lifecycle cost analyses of its
23		hydro plants, where required, as part of proposed capital projects to refurbish those hydro
24 25		plants. For example, in the 2024 Capital Budget Application, Newfoundland Power
25 26		completed a lifecycle cost analysis for the Lookout Brook Hydro Plant over a study
26		period of 50 years. The analysis demonstrated that continued operation of the plant will
27		provide an economic benefit to customers over the longer term. <sup>2</sup>
