10 11 A. The Board has stated that a three-year period between general rate applications is generally consistent with sound utility regulation. The Company observes that in practice, the Board maintains this three-year cycle. The three previous dates established by the Board for filing of the Company's general rate applications were June 1, 2024, June 1, 2021 and June 1, 2018. As such, the Company anticipates that the Board would require it to file its next general rate application no later than June 1, 2027.
