In addition, the Board did not address the issues raised in relation to the operation of the Industrial Customer RSP in Order No. P.U. 14(2017), noting that the Industrial Customer Group requested that Hydro provide more information with respect to deferred balances and associated class liabilities and potential offsets. The Board has established a process and issueda further information request to Hydro in relation to the Industrial Customer RSP.

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In addition, to assist the Board in its determinations related to both the Newfoundland
 Power and the Industrial Customer RSP, Hydro should provide an update of estimated

outstanding balances and Hydro's plans for disposition, for all deferral accounts and any
