THE BUSINESS OF AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE IN THE PROVINCE OF
NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR**

SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION - AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE FILING GUIDELINES

It has been brought to the attention of the Board that there was an error present in the Automobile Insurance Filing Guidelines issued on May 19, 2009. Section 2.3 outlining prohibited risk classification elements stated that “*length of time the insured has held a valid driver license in Canada or the USA*” was prohibited from use in an insurers risk classification system. This is not the case. This provision is prohibited from use as a ground for refusal, but is acceptable for use in the risk classification system.
