IN THE MATTER OF an application by Newfoundland and Labrador Hydro ("Hydro") for approval of the rates to be charged to Labrador Interconnected Customers (Rate Class 2.1H, 2.2H, 2.3H, 2.4H, 1.1W, 2.1W, 4.1W, 4.11W, and 4.12W) and Isolated General Service Customers (excluding Government departments) (Rate Class 2.1D and 2.2D), pursuant to Section 70 of the *Act*.

WHEREAS Hydro is a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Province of

Newfoundland and Labrador, is a public utility within the meaning of the Act and is also subject to

the provisions of the EPCA, 1994; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 14(2004) the Board approved:

- i A five-year phase-in of the implementation of uniform rates for customers served by Hydro on the Labrador Interconnected System; and
- ii A three-year phase-in of a demand-energy rate structure and the elimination of the lifeline block for Hydro's Isolated General Service customers; and

WHEREAS in Order No. P.U. 14(2004) (p. 165, item 6) the Board directed Hydro to file a revised Schedule of Rates no later than November 30 for each subsequent year for rate changes proposed in accordance with:

- i The five-year phase-in of the implementation of uniform rates for customers served by Hydro on the Labrador Interconnected System; and
- ii The three-year phase-in of a demand-energy rate structure and the elimination of the lifeline block for Hydro's Isolated General Service customers; and

WHEREAS on November 30, 2005 Hydro filed an Application requesting that the Board make an Order approving Hydro's rates as set out in the Schedule attached to the Application for Labrador Interconnected Customers Rate Class 2.1H, 2.2H, 2.3H, 2.4H, 1.1W, 2.1W, 4.1W and 4.12W) and for Isolated General Service Customers (Rate Class 2.1D and 2.2D) to be implemented January 1, 2006; and

WHEREAS the Board is satisfied that the rates as filed by Hydro in the Schedules A attached to the Application for certain Labrador Interconnected Customers and for Isolated General Service and as proposed by Hydro are in compliance with Order No. P.U. 14(2004).

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Pursuant to Section 70 of the *Act*, the Board approves the Schedule of Rates for Hydro's Labrador Interconnected Customers and the Schedule of Rates for Hydro's Isolated Customers, attached hereto as Rates Schedules Pages 1 to 11, to be effective for consumption on and after January 1, 2006.
