IRREGULAR ROUTE SPECIALTY AMBULANCE SERVICE for the transportation of persons requiring medical attention or under medical care upon the request of a medical doctor or a registered nurse from Burgeo to any hospital, nursing home, first aid station or home for senior citizens within the Province of Newfoundland and Labrador, and upon the specific request of a medical doctor, registered nurse or a police officer between any two points within the province of Newfoundland and Labrador.
