<ol> <li>4.</li> <li>5.</li> </ol>	Federation shall file with the Board revised rate indications using the traditional incurred reported development method to derive its Bodily Injury loss development factors, as well as an Acciden Benefits future loss trend rate of $+1\%$ .
	Federation shall submit for the approval of the Board a revised rate filing with proposed rate which are no higher than the rate indications revised in accordance with this Order, setting our proposed effective dates.
6.	Federation may adjust the proposed rates to reflect the proposed effective dates in the trend period.
7.	The proposed discount program is approved.
8.	The proposed surcharge program is approved.
9.	The updated CLEAR rate group tables are accepted.
10.	The proposed changes to driving record progression for at fault accidents are accepted.
11.	Federation shall pay all the expenses of the Board arising from this filing.
