IN THE MATTER OF an application by Federation Insurance Company of Canada ("Federation") to implement revised rates for its Private Passenger class of business. (the "Application")

**WHEREAS** on July 18, 2008 Federation filed a revised rate indication as directed in Board Order No. A.I. 13 (2008); and

**WHEREAS** on July 18, 2008 the Board's actuarial consultants reported that the revised rate proposal was based on the factors and parameters determined by the Board to be reasonable and supported by the information submitted in connection with the filing; and

**WHEREAS** the Board is satisfied that the revised rate proposal reflects rates which are no higher than justified on the basis of the available information.
