14 applied to the Board for approval of rates for additional SEF 44 limits for its Interurban class of

18 not too high in the circumstances.

- 23 1. The proposed rates for additional SEF 44 limits received November 18, 2011 from Royal
24 & Sun Alliance Insurance Company of Canada for its Interurban class of business are
25 approved to be effective no sooner than February 1, 2012 for new business and April 1,
26 2012 for renewals.
